After showing off our costumes at our class parade, we learnt about different professions such as opticians, audiologists, dentists, doctors and nurses. We talked about which of our senses they help to look after and how this keeps our bodies fit and healthy.

The children had to complete simple tasks like putting on their coat or drawing a smiley face, first using their sight and then with a blindfold on! They were amazed how much they had to rely on their other senses to help them with simple tasks.
