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

## **Class Sunshine**

As always, we have had another busy week. Miss Taylor has been helping the children make Christmas pictures that you will shortly be able to purchase as multipacks of cards and other merchandise. Keep a look out for your email about this.



We have started reading a new book in our literacy lessons called How to Catch a Star. The children learnt the boy in the story wants to play with a star and spends his time dreaming of this. Grandma Fantastic brought us some new vocabulary including crave, long for, glittering, shimmers, dazzles, flickers, soaring and sprinting. Can you include any of these words in sentences?

In Maths we have been learning subitising, recognising patterns of numbers without the need to count them.



In our Understanding of the World lessons, we have started to look ahead to our end of topic outcome when we hope to perform a mini puppet show. This week we investigated a range of puppets and discovered they have moving parts and faces. We also designed our own sock puppets which we plan to make next week.

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# **Class Star & Class Moon**



This week we have started to get ready for our Nativity 'Born in a Barn'. We can't believe it's that time of year again either! We have started to learn some songs and actions. Lyrics will be coming home this week so that adults can support with practising our songs at home. You will also have receiveed a letter regarding their part in the Nativity and the costume that will be needed. Next week, children will come home with their words to learn. We will of course be supporting children with their lines during the performance so please don't panic about these!

In Maths, we have been learning all about circles and triangles. We have been recognising and sorting the shapes, looking at how many sides they have, whether the sides are straight or curved and how many corners they have. We have also been spotting circles around our classroom and collecting sticks to make triangle shapes.





We have been artists this week too, learning how to mix different paint colours using only the primary colours, white and black. The children loved experimenting and testing their predictions to see what shades they could create next.

In curriculum, we have been exploring different types of puppets such as hand puppets, finger puppets and string puppets. We are beginning to think about our curriculum outcome where we will be putting on our own little puppet show.
