

## Questions to ask when sharing a book

Link letter sounds to letter shapes—make sure you say the sound correctly.

Some words are tricky and can't be sounded out eg: *the, said...* so always point them out and read the whole word.

As much as possible sound out the words and blend together encouraging your child to do the same.

## Before reading the book:

Can you point to the title? or What is this? (pointing to the title)

What do you think this story will be about?

What might happen in the story?



## During the reading of the book:

What is happening here?

What is \_\_\_\_\_ doing?

What might happen next?

How do you think the story might end?

Is \_\_\_\_\_\_ friendly/ mean/ nice...?

What does \_\_\_\_\_ mean? (to check understanding of a word).



## At the end of the book:

Did you like this book? Why?

What was your favourite part? Why?

Which character did you like the best? Why?

Why did that character do ... (give a situation/ event from the story)?
