

Home Learning Tasks - Please complete one Maths and one English task in the morning each day.

Maths Look at 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p coins. Practise learning what coin is which and how you can tell. Such as the colour, shape, size. Challenge yourself to drawing the coins. You could also play shops using the coins with a family member

Practise number formation. Count from 1-15 trying to form the numbers correctly

Can you find objects from around the house and put them in height order. Starting with the shortest and going up to the longest. Challenge yourself by ordering up to 6 objects.

Look at some addition and subtraction work with numbers 1-10. Use resources from around the house to help you if needed. (pasta, pencils, cubes etc).

English
Practise forming letters correctly. Remember what way round each letter is and thinking about how we form them.

Practise key words. Making sure we know the by sight. Challenge yourself to be able to write as many as you can correctly from memory.

Make up sentences using your key words.

Re-read the book Mary Jones and her bible.
