Vocabulary	
Material	What an object is made from.
Properties	Describes the qualities of an object. E.g. its strength, its appearance, its movement.
Suitability	Right for something.
Durability	Is strong and lasts a long time
Fairtest	Only one thing is changed, all other things are kept the same when carrying out an investigation.
Absorbent	Able to soak up liquid quickly.
