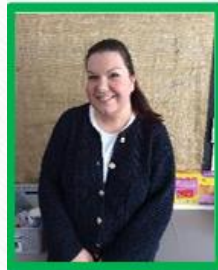

Daily Routines

- Work as a close unit with Moon Class
- Miss Cummins takes Reception children for Forest School
- Teaching Assistants support across both classes
- All Reception children (Moon and Star) will have access to the same provision, units of work & learning opportunities
- After initial teaching input has been delivered, children can mix across both classrooms and outdoors with all Reception children and the Year 1 children from Moon class



What a morning looks like

- Please see induction packs for start dates and times
- Drop off at the main gate
- Children are supported to put their belongings away and get busy with a registration task
- Register and welcome gathering
- Worship (to join after a few weeks)
- Daily phonics lesson
- Provision with guided adult-led activities to teach Maths and English curriculum



Lunch time

- Singing, story or news time whilst getting ready for lunch
- Lunch in the hall (family style sittings)
- Outside to play
- Lunchtimes supported by Teaching Assistants
- Peer massage every day after lunch



What an afternoon looks like

- Adult-led inputs covering wider curriculum areas
- Provision across both classrooms and outdoor area shared with Nursery
- Forest school
- Visits to the Jubilee Garden
- PE



End of the day

- Children are supported to get ready for home time and find their belongings
- Share a story and say our school prayer every day before home time
- Home time collection from gate at 3.30pm (3.15pm for the first 2 weeks)
- Please come forward to collect your child- come through gate and we cannot release children into the carpark



Snack

- Children can help themselves to fruit/veg throughout the day
- Children can help themselves to milk if they are on the milk list. Please see the leaflet about milk in your induction pack.
- Café Day will be starting later on in the year offering variety of snacks that children learn to prepare themselves



Buddies

- Support during transition
- Teddy Bears Picnic enjoyed with their buddies
- Weekly buddies sessions throughout the year



Church and School together

- Reverend Liz visits weekly to lead Worship
- Nativity performed in Church
- Special services (Harvest, Christmas, Easter, end of year)
- Daily prayers (end of day and before lunch)
- Reflection areas in each classroom



What children need
