Phonics Activity

Cut out the CVC word flashcards and pictures and spread the pictures out in front of you. Use your phoneme finger to press the sound buttons under each grapheme, before blending it back together, revealing the word! Once you have blended the word, find the matching picture. Can you remember any of our actions for the sounds?

What is a phoneme finger?

A phoneme finger is our index finger, which we use to 'press' the sound buttons as we say the corresponding phoneme when sounding out a word.

What are sound buttons?

Sound buttons are the dots underneath each grapheme which we 'press' when we sound out a word.

What are graphemes and phonemes?

Graphemes are the letters used to represent the phoneme we hear. A phoneme is the sound we hear.

We appreciate this learning being reinforced at home.
